An Overview to ALEKS Reports

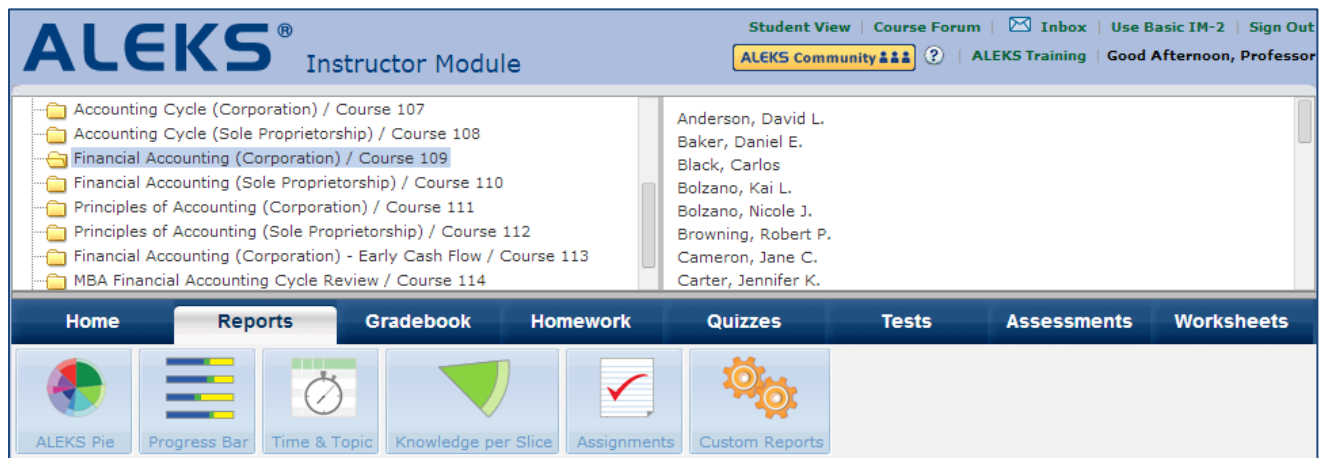
ALEKS offers a variety of automated reports that provide you with detailed information on student usage and learning. These dynamic reports will greatly help you to easily monitor progress, deliver data-driven instruction, and incorporate ALEKS into the grading system. Basic Instructor Module

Instructors can access reports from the Basic IM after selecting a class and then selecting the **Reports** tab.

Advanced Instructor Module

Instructors can access reports from the Advanced IM after selecting a class and then selecting the **Reports** tab. Clicking on a report icon will allow the instructor to generate a class report. To run a report for an individual student, first select the student's name from the right-hand panel, and then select the report icon.



ALEKS Pie Report shows average learning and can be used to direct instruction and group students based on topics they are currently ready to learn.

Progress Bar Report shows overall student progress and average learning rates. It can be used to monitor progress and identify students who may need intervention.

Time and Topic Report shows a daily breakdown of how students are spending their time in ALEKS. It can be used to monitor time on task and student learning patterns.

Knowledge Per Slice Report shows a breakdown of student progress for each slice of the ALEKS Pie (or Objectives if they are used) and can help monitor progress.

Assignments Report shows the results of automatically-graded ALEKS assignments, which include Homework, Quizzes, and Tests.

Custom Reports allow you to mix and match data from the existing ALEKS reports to create your own custom report.
