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Scenario: Homeschool Core Curriculum

Purpose: Enrichment/Gifted and Talented, Accommodate Learning Disabilities

Time Spent in ALEKS: 1 hour per day, 2 days per week

Total Time Spent Per Course: 30 hours per course

ALEKS Course: Algebra 1, High School Geometry, Algebra 2, PreCalculus
