Scenario

What challenges did the class or school face in math prior to using ALEKS? I have students that are very far behind grade level, as well as some who are on grade level or above it.

How many days per week is class time dedicated to ALEKS? 3 days per week.

What is the average length of a class period when ALEKS is used? 30 minutes.

Implementation

How do you implement ALEKS? They use ALEKS three days a week, and I go around and help them by answering questions.
